A short discussion was held concerning extending our Geotex runway by an additional 125 feet. More to come on this.

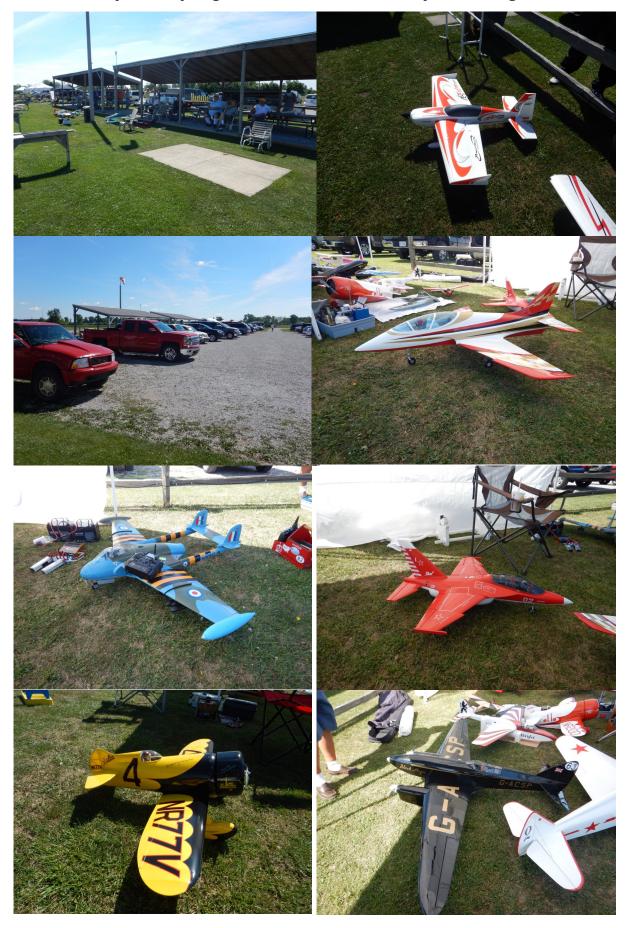
Meeting was closed at 7:20 followed by lots of flying.
