It has been quite an exciting year, and I'm truly blessed to say that I had more flights this year than almost any other in my 49 years of RC flying! I am aiming for my 50<sup>th</sup> year since my first RC solo flight in 2022. Wow, that seems like a long time and many airplanes ago!

I first want to say a sincere <u>Thank-You</u> to all who helped on our field workdays, all who worked hard to keep the field and equipment nice, and those who worked with us to welcome newcomers and people showing interest as this will pay off for years to come. Next, I want to let you know that we had a great year financially, member quantities, winning grants, and trying new things. We'll keep working incrementally to stay focused on the goal of being one of the best RC flying experiences in Indiana. All of us appreciate your help and cooperation in promoting safe and educational RC model operation.

I have to laugh; in my November note, I wrote to you about my SR-71 Project and my "mastering" of F-16's (finally.) In one week here in November, I found the SR-71 to only takeoff with stability, then depart from controlled flight at about 50-60 mph, and that incorrectly wiring an F-16's reverse thrust function prevents it from flying! Two jets down in one week and now lots and lots of spare parts as most all the equipment and power systems survived without a scratch. So goes test flights of new designs (apparently with a complex Center of Lift versus Center of Gravity issue) and maintenance/wiring errors! Sadly, the Horizon Hobby 80mm F-16, then converted to 8S power and flying superbly, was completely avoidable if I paid a bit more attention.


