Moving Forward into Fall

Hello everyone and I hope you have had some chances to enjoy some of the past nice days of flying weather we have had. Sadly, nightfall is coming noticeably sooner now and that evening calm time is getting shorter and shorter.

We had four good events this year and I wanted to thank all who did their part in both hosting the events as well as those who participated in the events. Please make sure to attend some flying events at other clubs throughout the year (still some in October) as this will grow our future club events. As a reminder, our club events accomplish the following.

Promotes RC aircraft to the public

Allows other non-member RC enthusiasts in the area to try our facility and possibly join Contributes funds to charitable causes, or, to our club

We now turn some attention to reconfiguring the flying field and doing some late year maintenance. This will be a minor inconvenience as there will be no flying while the field work is going on, but there will be flying before (early morning sun can be tough) and after the work is done. We unanimously agreed by all meeting participants at the September club meeting to move the crosswind runway to the North end of the main runway and will be doing this early in the day on October 2nd. We will also be staining and sealing the workbenches under the canopies and cleaning up the storage shed. Everyone is invited to come and help and continue to develop our facilities to be one of the best RC flying experiences in Indiana. Due to upcoming freeze and thaw events associated with the seasons, we will hold-off rolling the field until 2022 after the freezing subsides.

There is still time to get new airplanes completed and have some test flying done. I'm just now finishing up a twin 80mm EDF SR-71 airplane to test fly soon. It is 72" long and 46" span and is under 10lbs so far with batteries and all installed! I'm waiting for the corn to be removed and plan to test fly it prior to fully covering it. This is my most ambitious and unique self-designed project airplane! See below.

Minutes from the Indianapolis RC Modelers Meeting 6 September 2021

Meeting was opened at 7pm with 22 members in attendance

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved

Treasurers Report—We made a donation of \$1006.08 to the Toys for Tots program. As of tonight we have 73 members.. 2020 membership was 65

Discussion items:

Members had discussions during the last month about the wind sock position. Further discussion and it was agreed to have it directly across from the shelter on the far east side of the runway. We will have a tall pole to get it above the crops in the summer and then lower it for the winter.

Further discussion on the need to have allow 72mhz radio systems. It was moved and passed that we will only allow 2.4ghz radio systems at the field in the future. The new sign being made will have 2 rows of slots for membership cards and will note that only 2.4ghz radios are allowed.

Rolling the field will cost about \$600. We will wait and do this in the spring.

We will have a field work day on Saturday 2 Oct with a rain date of 9 Oct. We will move the cross runway to the north that day, stain the work tables and a few other projects.

We will also have the combat planes flying again after the work day on 2 Oct.

October meeting will be at the church because the sun will be setting earlier.
