October 2022 - Fall Arrives at Indy RC Modelers Club

Welcome to Fall of 2022 everybody. The evenings are noticeably shorter now and the air is becoming a lot cooler. That does help airplane performance some but doesn't help my fingertips and ears much! Still, there is a lot of great flying weather left.

We have just completed our largest flying event of the year. You will hear more at the October club meeting, but it was a great event. We had 40 registered pilots (tied for our most pilots at an event in recent years), about 100 airplanes on-site (helps when one guy brings 24 airplanes with him), and my informal count of non-participating pilots, spectators and visitors mid-day showed about 75 attendees on-site. We had revenues of \$1660 for the event, and after all expenses, net the club proceeds of \$868! That is \$361 better than the 2021 event. A sincere 'Thank You' to all who worked this event ahead of time, and all who jumped into the timer, mail giver/receiver, pylon judge, landing judge and impromptu flight control and re-entry manager roles during the fun-fly events. I especially appreciate those roles as they really do allow me to jump in and participate in the events without any way of influencing the competition outcomes. This is a really fun-time for all and I recommend your participation in the main fly-in and the simple and fun competition events. We pledge to keep these as truly fun, relatively easy, and fair competition events going forward.

One can also easily see the fruits of our Introduction Flight and Training programs as the Top-Gun Prop Pilot and the Overall Top-Gun Pilot for the 2022 All-Electric Fly-In and Fun-Fly were two of our younger and newer Level 2 pilots graduates from our training program! I LOVE the picture below and the grins say it all! Well done. (Note of caution...I'm aiming for the Top Gun trophy for next year!)



Like most, I feel the "building season" coming on. I have a few repairs to work on, and my unique, Don Marston Pterodactyl (modified to a cool little 50mm EDF powered glider setup – called "PteroJet"), and then keep drawing a couple of large twin-EDF jet projects.
